

CBPI Retired Accredited Member

Retired Accredited Membership is open to any current or past CBPI Accredited Member who has permanently ceased practicing, in a paid or voluntary capacity, as a CBT Psychotherapist. Renewal of accreditation and meeting the requirements for revalidation, are not necessary.

Requirements for Retired Accredited Members:

1. Applications must be submitted to CBPI for approval.
2. Retired Accredited Members must adhere to the CBPI Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct.
3. They may not practice as a CBPI accredited psychotherapist and may refer to themselves as “CBPI Retired Accredited Member” only.
4. Retired Accredited Members may not use the CBPI Accredited Member logo or present themselves other than “CBPI Retired Accredited Member” on any marketing or promotional materials, including print and media.
5. Retired Accredited Members will not be listed on the online CBPI or ICP register of accredited members.
6. Retired Accredited Members may attend CBPI workshops availing of member discount rates and may attend CBPI Annual General Meetings by invitation. They are not eligible to participate in voting.
